Dear Parents, Carers and Students

I hope this finds you all safe, fit and well.

The students in all year groups have been working really well. Attendance is high at over 96% across the school and I would like to thank you and the students for your support of the ongoing CV-19 safety measures that will remain in place. The school will continue to follow government guidance on CV-19 controls when providing both curricular and extra-curricular activities.

## Masks in school

We continue to follow Government guidance and therefore from Monday 17<sup>th</sup> May students will no longer need to wear masks in classrooms or communal areas. We understand that some people may feel nervous initially about the change and until half-term if a student wishes to continue to wear a mask we will allow them to do so. All other CV-19 safety measures remain in place including, for example, the year group bubbles, the one-way systems, 'split' lunch-time, hand sanitisers at classroom doors, and maintaining social distance as appropriate.

## Drinking Water

We encourage students to drink water during the school day. They may refill their water bottles at lunchtimes using the water stations that are located in the hall for their year group bubble. Working with the School Council, we are encouraging students to recycle plastic bottles using the green and blue recycling bins around school.

## Assessments

Our Year 11 and Year 13 students are completing their assessments to support the centre assessed grades that will help the exam boards to award the individual subject grades at GCSE and A level. Thank you for your support of your son/daughter at home through this period.

## Cycling

We are pleased that a significant number of our students cycle to school. Please encourage them to wear a helmet and observe the Highway Code. Thank you in anticipation.
