Friday 15th July 2022 – School Walk

This year's route follows a designated footpath along the River Kent to Levens Hall and back along the Lancaster canal path.

This is a positive experience where we walk as a school community (in forms) enjoying a day out together in our local area. For a few students, support will be given on a shorter route. It is expected that everyone takes part, unless there is a medical reason. Year 12 students will accompany forms and will support staff at marshalling points. Students are encouraged to make a £1 donation to the school charities on the day. There will well deserved ice creams and ice lollies available from the Cube at the end of the walk.

We expect all children to participate unless parents/carers make contact with their child's Head of Year to discuss a reason why their child should not take part.

The first walkers will leave school at 9.00 am and therefore everyone needs to be in their form rooms by 8.45 am as normal on that day.

At the end of the school walk students will sign back in to school and will then be free to leave school. This will be earlier than a normal school finish. If, however, you want your child to remain in school until 3.00 pm, please can you let your child's Head of Year know by Wednesday 13th July so that we can make arrangements.

Students do not have to wear school uniform and should dress appropriately for the weather. They will need to bring a packed lunch, snacks and a good-sized water bottle in a rucksack. Please also ensure that suitable footwear is worn along with water proofs or sun cream depending on the weather.
